

Topic: So plants move too!

Objective: Enhance students' ability to incorporate the skills they learn in school with real-life situations. This includes research and reasoning skills, team-working skills, proper communication as well as developing their own personal characteristics.

Assessed Subjects

Subject	Subject-specific objective
Science	Investigating types of movement in plants through research supported with evidence.
ICT	Preparing a report using MS_Word.

Project description

Students are expected to conduct research to investigate whether plants can move, explain types of movements, and provide evidence for their claims. Students will demonstrate their findings using their ICT skills in creating a Word document to record their data.

Teams

Students will;

- work in groups of 3 or 4 assigned by the teacher.
- prepare a word document to present their work.
- be allowed 5 min to present their work in class.
- Students will work in the period between May1st to May 20th.

During this time, students will be given 2 science classes and 1 ICT class to do their work. All other work will be done at home.

Submission Format / Details

Each student is to fill out the attached submission document and only the team leader uploads the Word document on LMS for every subject.

Resources

Students can refer to the Learning Centre at school, or refer to safe and acknowledged search engines, introduced and discussed in class.

Students have to refer to 3 different resources at least.

Students have to mention the resources they referred to.
