The Success Story of Larry Page, Co-founder of Google

Larry page is an American computer scientist and entrepreneur who, with Sergey Brin, created the online search engine Google, one of the most popular sites on the Internet. Larry Page is a very intelligent individual. He was born in 1974, and from an early age he showed signs of being exceptional at math and science, page initially studied electrical engineering at Stanford University, but he soon realized that he had a greater interest in computer science.

He had no idea what he wanted to do with his life, but he knew he had a passion for computers. pages father was a professor of computer science at Michigan State University, received a computer engineering degree from the university of Michigan (1995) and entered into the doctorate program at Standford where he met Brin. The two were both interested with the idea of enhancing the ability to extract meaning from the mass of data gathered on the internet, working from page's dormitory room, they devised a new type of search engine technology that leveraged Web users They called their expanded search engine Google—a name derived from a misspelling of the word *googol* Page and Brin raised about \$1 million in outside financing from investors, family, and friends. By September 1998 the two had founded Google Inc., with Page as chief executive officer (CEO). The next year Google received \$25 million of venture capital funding and was processing 500,000 queries per day.

However, Larry Page's story is not without its challenges. In his early days at Google, the company faced many challenges including a lack of funding and competition from more established rivals. but, with determination and a dedication to their vision, Larry and Sergey were able to turn Google into one of the world's most successful companies The company has become an essential part of our lives, and Larry Page's story is a testament to the power of hard work and determination.
