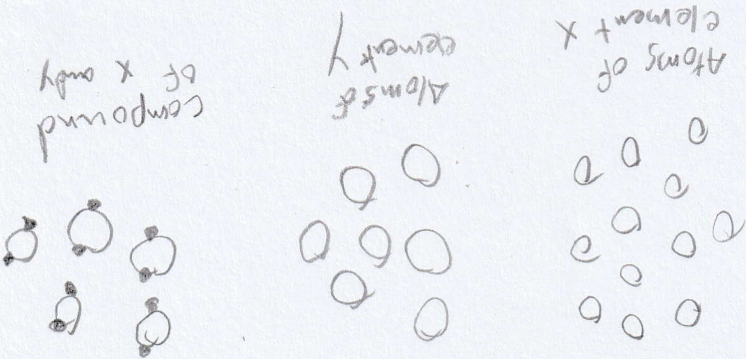
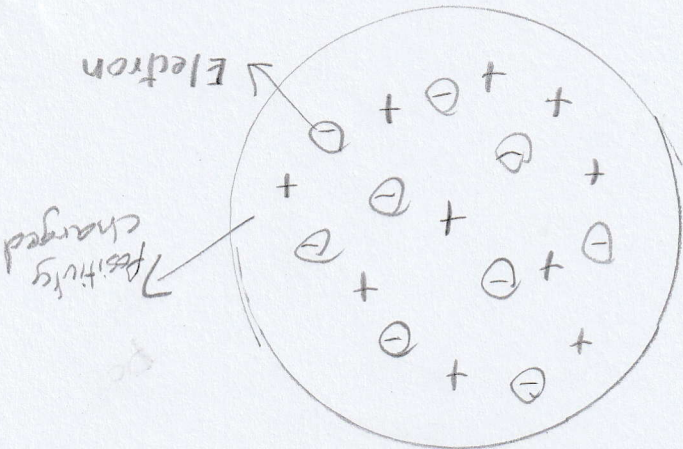


Dalton's model of atoms 1808

J.J. Thompson plum pudding model 1904
 Discovered that atoms have electrons
 Atoms are not indivisible they are made of
 smaller things, positively charged
