

Answers:

Ex. A. Put the following events in the order they happen.

1. Ariel conjures up a huge storm to scare Alonso and Antonio.
2. A ship is caught in a tempest and sinks.
3. Prospero tells Miranda that he made Ariel create the storm.
4. The passengers are washed up safely on different parts of the island.
5. Ariel fetched Ferdinand, who falls in love with Miranda.
6. Alonso is miserable as he believes his son is dead.
7. Alonso, Antonio and the countries are chased by wild animals.
8. Ariel scares Alonso and Antonio.

Exercise: B

1. Betrayed: to go against or let someone down who trusts you.

Gratitude: to feel grateful, happy about someone's kindness towards you

Lures: attract someone with something.

Bedraggled: pathetic looking, dirty and /or wet.

2. The text implies that Prospero and his daughter were not expected to survive. There are two pieces of evidence which suggest this. They were put to sea on 'an old rotten boat' and the text say 'amazingly they survived'.

3. For example: Prospero wanted Ferdinand alone so he could bring him to Miranda and so that he could punish Alonso by making him think his son is dead. Alonso, Antonio and the other sailors will be more vulnerable in smaller groups than being all together.

4. The text implies that it is part of Prospero's plan for Miranda and Ferdinand to meet and fall in love.

-Clues: he hides so that Ferdinand can marry his daughter; Prospero asks Ariel to bring everyone together and prepare a special masquerade banquet to celebrate the wedding.

5. Antonio and Alonso are both punished because they are terrified by the wild animals.
