Function :1. Future plans. It doesn't have to be for the near future.
2. predictions that are based on evidence.
* Negative form : be (not) + going to + (infinitive)
Be: * is / * are / * am

We use the Future Continuous (will + be + main verb in the -ing form) to talk about a continuous action in the future.
