## Spelling adverbs – exceptions to the rule

Page 16 of the Workbook teaches students about some adverbs that don't follow the rules (e.g. good, bad). They practise using well, worse and better. This is not extensive and may serve as a useful end-of-lesson activity rather than as a homework assignment.

## **Answers**

- 1. a. She revised well for her weekly test.
  - b. He played better for Atletico Bueno.
  - Sergio plays the drums worse than Monica.
- Anya can play the harp better than Beatrice and performs in concerts.
  - b. The team played worse after the half-time interval and the goalkeeper let in five goals.
