Objective/s:

- Identify simple present tense.
- Use simple present tense in affirmative, negative, questions and short answers.

Simple Present Tense:

Class: Grade 4 National (All Sections)

	Subject	<u>Main Verb</u>				
<u>Affirmative</u>	I/ We/You/They	go	to bed early.			
	He/She/It	goes				
Negative	I/We/You/ They don't go		to bed early.			
	He/ She/ It	doesn't go				
Question	Do	I/ you/we/they go	To bed early?			
	Does	he/she/it go	To bed early?			
Positive Short	Yes, I/we/you/they do.					
Answer	Yes, he/she/it does.					
Negative Short	No, I/we/you/they don't.					
Answer	No, he/she/it doesn't.					















***Use the Present Simple for:**

1. Daily routine:

- I go to school every day.
- Every morning, he wakes up, washes his face and brushes his teeth.
- 2. Habits: Use adverbs of frequency: (always, usually, sometimes, often, hardly ever, never)
 - I always call my parents on Sundays.
 - I often go to the cinema.
 - He usually doesn't like going to bed early.

3. Facts:

- The sun rises from the east.
- The planets go around the sun.

*Third person: Add (s) to the verb in the affirmative form after he, she or it.

*The rules of adding third person singular (s):

1. Adding (-es):

*With verbs that end in (ch, sh, x, o, z, or s): add (-es)

- He wat**ches** TV every night.
- She wa**shes** her face every morning.
- A mechanic fixes cars.
- He g**oes** to school every day.
- The bee buz**zes**.
- He mis**ses** his family a lot.















2. Adding (-ies):

- With verbs that end in a **consonant** and **(y)**: delete **(y)** and add **(-ies)**:
 - The student <u>stud**ies**</u> well for his exams. (stu**dy**)
- With verbs that end in a **vowel** (**a**, **e**, **i**, **o**, **u**) and (**y**): keep the (y) and just add (-s):
 - He plays football on Tuesdays.

*The form of "have" after (he/she/it) is "has".
