Remember

We use Will/Won't to talk about facts in the future.

Example:

Jane will be 13 years old next week.

We Will/Won't to make predictions about things you believe.

Example:

I will visit Mary tomorrow morning.

We use "be going to" to talk about future plans.

Example:

Next week, I am going to go to the Dead Sea.

We use "be going to" to make predictions about things you see.

Example:

Look at that man! He is going to fall.

(Prediction Seen)

9. Look at that boy at the top of that tree! He **is going to fall** (fall). (Prediction Seen)

10. The bus **will leave** (leave) at 3:45 p.m. (Future Facts)

11. Jana **will be** (be) sixteen years old next month. (Future Facts)

12. Look at that car! It **is going to crash** (crash). (Prediction Seen)
