

# Using pronouns

## Answers

You could explain that the category of personal pronouns includes both subject and object pronouns.

1. Subject pronouns: I, you, he, she, it, we, they  
Object pronouns: me, you, him, her, it, us, them
2.
  - a. It entertains them greatly.
  - b. She had to act with him.
  - c. We sent them for her.
  - d. They thanked all of us.
3. Let the students have some fun reading out the lady's speech. Then elicit all the personal pronouns: I, you, it, it, they, it, it, she, she, it.
  - c. Possessive pronouns

4. Accept any three sentences using any of the possessive pronouns (mine, yours, his, hers, its, ours, theirs) correctly.

  - a. herself
  - b. myself
  - c. themselves
6. Singular '-self', plural '-selves

  - a. They are relative pronouns.
  - b. You use 'who' to refer to people and 'which' to refer to things.
9.
  - a. He gave the script to his brother who learned his lines in two days.
  - b. I had problems with the stage lighting which kept on breaking the circuit.
