#### **Prefixes:**

- A prefix is a word part that is added to the beginning of a word to change its meaning.
- Here are some common prefixes and their meanings:

**Un-:** This prefix means "not" or "the opposite of." **For example**, unhappy, unsure, and unfair.

Re-: This prefix means "again" or "back." For example, rewrite, return, and rebuild.

Pre-: This prefix means "before" or "in advance." For example, preview, predict, and preheat.

Mis-: This prefix means "wrong" or "incorrectly." For example, misunderstand, misplace, and misinterpret.

Bi-: This prefix means "two" or "both." For example, bicycle, bifocal, and bilingual.

#### **Suffixes:**

- A suffix is a word part that is added to the end of a word to change its meaning or part of speech.
- Here are some common suffixes and their meanings:
- **-Ful:** This suffix means "full of" or "having." **For example**, cheerful, peaceful, and helpful.
- **-Ly:** This suffix means "in a certain way" or "like." **For example**, quickly, happily, and carefully.
- **-Er:** This suffix means "more" or "one who." **For example**, bigger, stronger, and teacher.
- **-Ness:** This suffix means "state of being" or "quality of." **For example**, kindness, happiness, and emptiness.
- **-Ing:** This suffix can indicate the present participle form of a verb or can be used to form adjectives. **For example**, running (present participle of "run"), exciting, and interesting.
