

The past simple:

(الماضي البسيط)

Form: V2 (the second form of the verb)

Regular play → played

Irregular come → came

Negative: didn't + base

Question: Did + S + base ?

Indicators:

yesterday, (last + زمن), ago, ((in / on) + زمن ماضي), in the past,
at that time, at the time, (once لا يأتي بعدها زمن)

* لنفي الماضي البسيط، فإننا نستخدم (didn't + base) مع كل الأفعال ما عدا افعال Be
اذ اننا ننفيها اما باستخدام wasn't او weren't

- We(go) swimming yesterday.
- Ahmad(buy) a second-hand car last week .
- For breakfast last Tuesday, Farah(make) coffee in a new kind of machine. It(taste) horrible and everyone(spit) it out .
- Our basketball team(fly) to Syria three months ago.
- My friend(phone) me two hours ago.
- Last Sunday, the school (hold) a parent teacher meeting.
- Our school (go) on a picnic last week.
- I (buy) a lot of useful books yesterday.
- Farah(finish) writing her report last night.
- Sami(visit) the doctor last Wednesday.
- The Gulf war(start) in 1991.
- Omar(not watch) the movie last night.
- Omar visited us yesterday and(stay) for lunch.

- The policethe thief two days ago. (arrest ,arrested ,has arrested ,arrests)
- We.....a lot of work yesterday. (did , have done , do , does)

USES : WE USE THE PAST SIMPLE TO:

1. talk about **something that started and finished in the past.**

- I (meet) a friend of mine **yesterday** .
- The postman (bring) me three letters **yesterday** .
- We (go) to Syria **last Summer**. We (catch) the 9: 20 plane .

2. describe a **routine in the past.** (Past habits)

- When he was young, he rarely talked to strangers.
- At the age of seven, Ahmad often ate meat.

3. talk about something that was true for an extended period of time in the past. In this case, we use it with a time phrase. (Permenant state)

- When I lived in Amman, I worked in a bank.
- Tom's father taught him to drive when he was 17.
- When she heard a strange noise, she got up to investigate.

Past Continuous: (الماضي المستمر)

FORM: (I + مفرد) was
(جمع) were + (base + ing)

Indicators:

when, while, as,

at this time last week, this time last yearetc.
at 5 o'clock yesterday morning , at 8 o'clock yesterday,
from 6 o'clock to 8 o'clock yesterday morning

Uses : We use the past continuous to:

1. talk about something which was happening before and after another action in the past.

- He (play) tennis at 4:30 yesterday .
- At eight yesterday , Farah (have) breakfast .

2. show that something happened for a long time in the past.

- While I (get) dressed , the mobile phone rang .
- Amal (talk) on the phone when I arrived .
- As Farah (type) the letter , she noticed many spelling mistakes .
- What you(do) when I phoned you ?

Past continuous indicators

***While/as

1. (While/as)+past continuous, past continuous.

(While /as) he was doing his homework, his sister was playing with her dolls.

2. Past continuous +(while/as) + past continuous.

He was doing his homework (as/while) his sister was playing with her dolls.

3. Past simple +(while/as)+past continuous.

The bell rang (as/while) the teacher was collecting the test papers.

***When

4. When +past simple, past continuous.

When he came home, I was reading a book.

5. Past continuous, when +past simple.

I was reading a book when he came home.

6. When +past simple, past simple. (narrating events)

When he entered the room, he saw the mouse on the table so he screamed.

7. When + simple past, past perfect / already

When he arrived, we had already left.

- They were having dinner when they a scream. (hear)
- I Ali while I was driving to the station. (see)
- I television at 8 o'clock last night.
(watch, have watched, was watching, watches)
- We weren't at home at 4 o'clock yesterday evening; we our relatives.
(were visiting, have visited, visit, have been visiting)
- This time last year, we in Syria.
(have been touring, were touring, tour, had toured)
- He a football match from 4 o'clock to 6 o'clock yesterday evening.
(has been watching, watch, had watched, was watching)
- At this time last month, they their first baby's birthday.
(were celebrating, have celebrated, celebrate, had celebrated)
- The telephone rang while he a bath.
(had, have, was having, has been having)
- We at a high speed when the accident happened.
(drove, have driven, were driving, drive)
- It began to rain while I in the park.
(was walking, walked, had walked, walk)
- While she the ladder, she slipped off.
(climb, climbed, had climbed, was climbing)
- When he reached his office, the workers for him.
(was waiting, were waiting, waited, has been waiting)
- The police caught him while he the car.
(opened, was opening, opens, had opened)
- While I was walking down the street, he into an old friend.
(ran, run, had run, was running)
- We were doing our homework when the lights out.
(go, went, were going, had gone)
- She slept as she her book.
(read, reads, was reading, had read)
- As he the film, the doorbell rang.
(was watching, watched, watches, has watched)
- She (sleep) when the doorbell rang.
- When I arrived, my friends (play) chess.

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- 2001: The old man to music when the police opened the door. (listen)
- 1999: Randa the report when I left the office. (finalise)
- 2017: The students in my class about their achievements in science when the bell suddenly rang. (talk)

Past Perfect Simple:

(الماضي التام)

FORM: had + P.P

We use the Past Perfect Simple to talk about actions that happened before a specific moment in the past.

Indicators:

before, after, as soon as, by + (زمن ماضي), until
(بشرط أن يكون الفعل الآخر الموجود في الجملة في حالة الماضي، او وجود اي دلالة اخرى ((already, just, never)) من دلالات الماضي التام)

NOTE: The Past Perfect is used to show the reason of a past result:

1. I *couldn't* play because I **had broken** my leg.
2. He *bought* a car because he.....his driving license.
(has got , had got , will get)
3. He *was* bleeding because he.....his finger.
(cuts , has cut , had cut)
4. I *couldn't* open the door because I.....the key.
(had lost , have lost , loose)
5. There *was* nobody at home because they.....out.
(have been going, have gone, had gone)

***After

1. After + past perfect, past simple.
After I **had had** lunch, I **did** the washing up.
2. Simple past + after + past perfect.
I **did** the washing up after I **had had** lunch.

***Before

3. Before + past simple, past perfect.
Before I **went** to bed, I **had done** my homework.
4. Past perfect + before + past simple.
I **had done** my homework before I **went** to bed.

***By

5. By+ simple past, past perfect , by 2013
By the time I **reached** the train station, the train **had left** so I had to take a taxi.

By 2013, she **had finished** her research.

6. Past perfect + by+ past simple
The train **had left** by the time I **reached** the station.

***When

7. When + past simple, already + past perfect
When he **arrived**, the film **had already** started.

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8. Already + past perfect + when + simple past.
The film had already started when I arrived.

***Because

Because + past perfect, past simple .

9. Because he hadn't passed the test, he was sad.

10. Past simple because + past perfect

Maher felt nervous because he hadn't swum in the sea.
