Protect	To <b>save</b>	It's important to <b>protect</b> your skin from the harmful effects of the sun.
Inspire	To <b>influence</b> .	The nature <b>inspires</b> artist to paint beautiful pictures.
Fascinate	To <b>attract</b>	The sky was sparkly enough to <b>fascinate</b> her.

Diverse	<b>Many kinds /various</b>	The wild life is <b>diverse</b> .

Starving	extremely hungry	There are lots of homeless people who are <b>starving</b> .
Damaged	<b>Destroyed.</b>	The house was <b>damaged</b> by the storm.

Foothills	low <b>hills</b> at the base of a mountain range.	We marched 5 km across the <b>foothills</b> .
Tracker	A person who is trained to find animals or people. / <b>tracer</b>	Police and <b>trackers</b> were searching for the lost boy.
Naturalist	A person who studies living things. / <b>zoologist</b>	Jim Corbett was a great <b>naturalist</b> .
Injury	<b>Harm</b> or damage that is done in the body of a person or animal.	He is recovering from a knee <b>injury</b> .
Wound	A <b>cut</b> .	Blood was pouring from the <b>wound</b> .
Poaching	<b>Catching or Killing animals illegally</b>	The reason for <b>poaching</b> tigers is to sell their skins and bones.
Conservation	<b>Protection</b> of the natural world.	The lake was recently designated a <b>conservation</b> area.
Preservation	<b>Keeping</b> something in the same or good condition.	The <b>preservation</b> of the mummy was great.

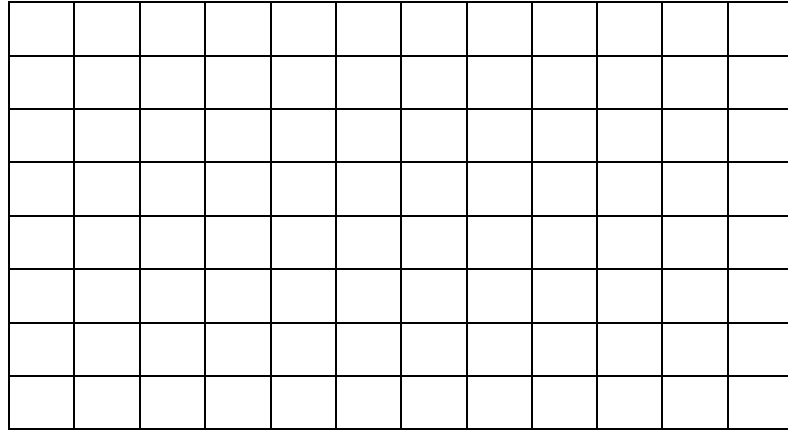
