spelling:

 Regular verbs ending in a silent -e take /-d/ in the simple past and past participle.

Close

Closed

 Regular verbs ending in a vowel + y take /-ed/ in the simple past and past participle.

Play

Played

 Regular verbs ending in a consonant + y take /-ied/ in the simple past and past participle (the y becomes an i followed by /-ed/).

Mar<u>ry</u>

Married

 All the other regular verbs take /-ed/ in the simple past and past participle.

We use the past simple for:

1. A completed action in the past.

I saw a movie yesterday.

Last year I traveled to Japan.

She didn't go to school last week.

2. A series of completed actions.

I finished work, walked to the beach, and found a nice place to swim.

Did you add flour, pour in the milk, add sugar, and then add the eggs?
