

4. To express annoyance (always)

You are always talking in class.

My brother **is always using** my things without permission.



now, right now, nowadays, at present, at the moment, currently, still,

tonight, today, tomorrow, Listen! Look! Be careful!

always (to express annoyance)

next + time (next week, year, Monday),

this + time (This week, this Tuesday, this evening)
