# **Order of Adjectives**

(OPSASH.COM P)

In many languages, <u>adjectives</u> usually occur in a specific order. Generally, the adjective order in English is:

OPINION	SIZE	AGE	SHAPE	COLOUR	ORIGIN	MATERIAL	PURPOSE	NOUN
beautiful	big	new	square	brown	Indian	leather	travelling	bag
awful	large	old	round	yellow	Italian	plastic	storing	box
stylish	long	new	baggy	blue	Spanish	cotton	dancing	dress

For example:

- 1. I love that **really big old green antique** car that is always parked at the end of the street.7
- 2. My sister adopted a **beautiful big white** bulldog.

When there are two or more adjectives that are from the same group, the word **and** is placed between the two adjectives:

- 1. The house is green **and** red.
- 2. The library has old **and** new books.

When there are three or more adjectives from the same adjective group, place a comma between each of the coordinate adjectives:

- 1. We live in the big green, white and red house at the end of the street.
- 2. My friend lost a **red**, **black** and **white** watch.

A comma is not placed between an adjective and the noun.
