Structure and content

The report has a catchy title

The report has a by-line

The report is written in paragraphs

First paragraph summarizes the story. It answers the 4Ws- Who, What, Where, When

Rest of the report answers- How and Why

The report includes eye-witness quotation

The report includes facts and opinions

Sentences make sense and are clear

Vocabulary

Report has interesting words and synonyms

Punctuation and grammar

Sentences have full stops, question marks or exclamation marks at the end

There are capital letters at the beginning of sentences, names and places

Speech marks and saying verbs are used correctly in quotations

The report is written in the past tense

Spelling

Common words are spelled correctly and new words are decodable

Handwriting

Letters are in a good size and have regular spaces between them handwriting is clear
