

Find out notes:

1. Present simple = verb.1 or verb +s/es / ies
E.g.: clean – play – swims – washes - cries
2. Negative in the present simple = doesn't + v.1 – don't +v.1
E.g.: doesn't do – don't go
3. Past simple = regular verb (verb + d/ed) or irregular (v.2)
E.g.: jumped – cooked – went – drank
4. Negative in the past simple = didn't + v.1
E.g.: didn't write – didn't read
5. Present continuous = am / is / are + verb + ing
E.g.: am going – is cleaning – are listening
6. Past continuous = was / were + verb + ing
E.g.: was eating – were shouting
7. Modals of ability = can / can't – could / couldn't – will be able to / won't be able to
8. Subject pronoun = I / you / he / she / it / we / they
(at the beginning of a sentence.)
9. Object pronoun = me / you / him/ her/ it / us / them
(in the middle or at the end of a sentence)
- 10.Preposition = in / on / to / for / at / with / into / of
- 11.Conjunction = but / or / so / because / and

12. Adjective = a word that describes a noun

Example: new – old – beautiful – big – numbers - colours
